Sale Bird Area Contract

Updated February 24, 2010

1. Each seller may bring no more than 6 birds valued at \$100.00 or more or 12 birds valued under \$100.00.
2. Cages must be clean and not overcrowded. Fresh food and water must be available. There need to be enough perches for every bird. Cages must fit safely on one 6' round or 6' rectangular table.
3. All birds will be checked by the show veterinarian upon arrival, or at the vet's earliest convenience.
4. Payment to the club shall be made upon arrival as follows:
 - \$1.00 for each bird to be sold for \$25.00 or under
 - \$2.00 for each bird to be sold for \$25.01-\$50.00
 - \$4.00 for each bird to be sold for \$50.01-75.00
 - \$6.00 for each bird to be sold for \$75.01-100.00
 - \$8.00 for each bird to be sold for \$100.01-\$150.00
 - \$12.00 for each bird to be sold for \$150.01-250.00
 - \$15.00 for each bird to be sold for \$250.01 or more.
5. The Club will provide each vendor with either a single 6' or 8' round table or 6' rectangular table on a first come first served basis along with 1 chair per table. There are no electrical outlets available in the Sale Bird Area. Please bring your own table coverings and clean your area thoroughly before leaving.
6. The Sale Bird area will open at 8:00 a.m. and any one interested in selling birds must arrive between 8:00-10:00 a.m. Tags will be issued for each bird brought for sale and will include a description of the bird and the stated selling price.
7. The area will be checked periodically throughout the day by club members.
8. Sellers are responsible for their own entrance fee paid at arrival.
